

## Explanation of ISEF Forms

Forms	Title	Purpose
1	<a href="#">Checklist for Adult Sponsor</a>	This completed form is required for <b>ALL</b> projects and must be completed <b>before</b> experimentation. The adult sponsor is the person overseeing the student and the project.
1A	<a href="#">Student Checklist</a>	This form is required for <b>ALL</b> projects. It will provide basic information about the student. <i>There is also a paper on completing the research plan for the project.</i>
1A # 9	<a href="#">Research Plan &amp; Instructions</a>	A complete research plan is required for <b>ALL</b> projects and must accompany the Checklist for Student (1A). Must be completed <b>before</b> experimentation.
1A # 10	<a href="#">SSEF Official Abstract and Certification Form</a>	Required for <b>ALL</b> projects. A 250 word, one-page summary of the project which must be written on the official form provided by the State Science and Engineering Fair of Florida (SSEF).
1B	<a href="#">Approval Form</a>	This completed form is required for <b>ALL</b> projects for each student, including all team members.
1C	<a href="#">Regulated Research Institution/ Industrial Setting</a>	This form must be completed <b>after</b> experimentation by the adult supervising the student research conducted in a regulated research institution, industrial setting or any work site other than home, school or field. (Regulated research institutions include universities, medical centers, industrial settings, NIH, etc.)
2	<a href="#">Qualified Scientist Form</a>	May be required for research involving human subjects, vertebrate animals, potentially hazardous biological agents, and DEA-controlled substances. Must be completed <b>before</b> the start of student experimentation. This form gives information about the Qualified Scientist who will supervise the student and the project.
3	<a href="#">Risk Assessment Form</a>	Required for <b>ALL</b> projects using hazardous chemicals, activities or devices. Must be completed <b>before</b> student experimentation.
4	<a href="#">Human Subjects Form</a>	Required for <b>ALL</b> research involving human subjects. <b>IRB approval is required before experimentation.</b>
	Sample of <a href="#">Informed Consent Form</a>	This form is used to provide information to the research subject (or parent/guardian) and to document written informed consent, minor assent and/or parental permission.
5A	<a href="#">Vertebrate Animal Form</a> – (conducted in a non-regulated research site)	Required for <b>ALL</b> research involving vertebrate animals that is conducted in a Non-Regulated Research Site. <b>(SRC approval required before experimentation.)</b> Form 5A is for research conducted in a Non-Regulated Research Site.

5B	<a href="#">Vertebrate Animal Form</a> (conducted in a regulated research institution)	Required for <b>ALL</b> research involving vertebrate animals that is conducted at a Regulated Research Institution. <b>(IACUC approval required before experimentation.)</b>
6A	<a href="#">Potentially Hazardous Biological Agents Risk Assessment Form</a>	Required for <b>ALL</b> research involving microorganisms, rDNA, fresh/frozen tissue, blood and body fluids. <b>SRC/IACUC/IBC approval required before experimentation.</b>
6B	<a href="#">Human and Vertebrate Animal Tissue Form</a>	Required for <b>ALL</b> projects using fresh/frozen tissue, primary cell cultures, blood, blood products and body fluids. If the research involves living organisms, please ensure that the proper human or animal forms are completed. <b><i>All projects using any tissue listed above, must also complete Form 6A.</i></b>
7	<a href="#">Continuation Projects Form</a>	Required for projects that are a continuation in the same field of study as a previous project. <b><i>This form must be accompanied by the previous year's abstract, Form (IA) and Research Plan.</i></b>
